
8. Swords Pavillion Shopping Centre

3.Skerries Mills

A short 25 minutes north of Shoreline Hotel and you are at Skerries Mills complex which comprises a watermill, 5-sail windmill, 4-sail windmill and associated mill races, mill pond and wetlands. The history of the mill can be traced to the early 16th century and a bakery was established on the site by 1840.

4.Guinness Store House

With only a 34 minute drive to the iconic Guinness Storehouse it is a great trip out. With seven unique floors, the Guiness Storehouse is a fun day out featuring installations, educational videos, 'Pull Your Own Pint' workshops and finished off with a trip to the Gravity Bar on the seventh floor which boasts 360-degree views of Dublin.

5. Jameson Distillery The Old Jameson Distillery is located just off Smithfield Square on the Northside of the city. Originally built in 1780, this Distillery is the original site where Jameson Irish Whiskey was distilled . It is now a visitors centre that provides guided tours, whiskey tasting workshops, bars, restaurants and a giftshop. On the tour you will re-live the history and discover the secret of how just three ingredients are transformed into the spirit known as Jameson Irish Whiskey.

6. Trinity College and the Book of Kells

A walk through the cobbled stones of Trinity College Dublin will bring visitors back to the 18th century. The Library of Trinity College is the largest research library in Ireland and boasts breathtaking architecture, with three million books held in the depository. The Book of Kells is a 9th-century gospel manuscript and considered one of the most beautiful illuminated manuscripts in the world.

7. Christ Church Cathedral

Christ Church Cathedral is Dublin's oldest building and at just 33 minutes from Shoreline Hotel it makes it very accessible as top visitor attraction you can easily get around, as a place of pilgrimage since 1000AD the history itself makes it a worthy visit. Cocoon yourself in history in the heart of Medieval Dublin, where Christ Church Cathedral is renowned for its beautiful architecture, exquisite interior design and is home to the famous 12th Century crypt, one of the oldest and largest in Britain and Ireland.

8. O'Connell Street

No visit to Dublin is complete without a walk along the most famous of all streets in Dublin. O'Connell Street is less than 30 minutes from Shoreline Hotel and you are in the beating heart of the capital city dotted with shops, bars and restaurants there's lots to see and do, however this humble street is home to what could be considered the most famous building in Ireland - The General Post Office (GPO). Opened in 1818, this is one of the city's most beloved structures.

9. Dublin Zoo

Dublin Zoo has a variety of areas featuring some of the worlds animals including a Orangutan Forest, Fringes of the Arctic, Sea Lion Cave, African Plains, House of Reptiles and City Farm. A 25 minute trip will take you to Dublin Zoo which covers over 69 acres of Phoenix Park, not to be missed.

10. Newgrange A 40 minute drive from the Shoreline Hotel Newgrange is a 5,200 year old passage tomb located in the Boyne Valley in Ireland's Ancient East. Newgrange was built by a farming community that prospered on the rich lands of the Boyne Valley. Newgrange have been designated a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Take in the scenic views white enjoying a guided tour.
